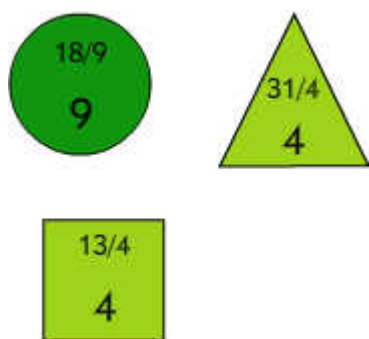
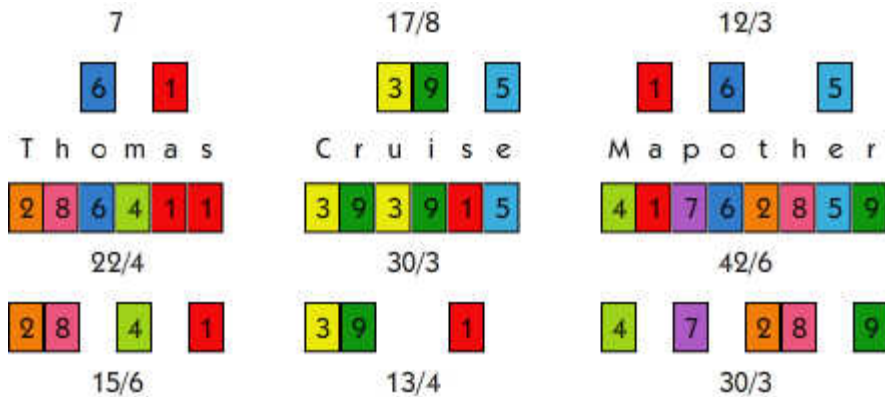

How Your Name Numbers Stack Up

Tom, we begin by taking a quick snapshot, a look at the influence and meaning of the three core numbers derived from your name. Your Expression number is the sum of the value of all the letters in your full name at birth. Your Heart's Desire is the sum of the vowels. Your Personality number is the sum of the consonants. These three numbers are closely linked and influence one another.

All the numbers derived from your name reflect YOU. They are a blueprint of your talents, shortcomings, character traits, and other qualities. You should realize that this is a limited perspective. Later chapters focus on the challenges and opportunities you will encounter on your path, and attributes you may acquire as time passes.

This first chapter is like a glance from a distance, followed by three chapters that

explain the meaning of each number in more detail. We will gradually build a more complete picture of the complex and unique individual you are.

Your Core Numbers

Tom, your Heart's Desire number is 9, and your Expression and Personality are both 4. Although the Expression number usually carries more weight, your numbers suggest the Heart's Desire traits are more defining. For example, if you have a friend who is organized and detail oriented, but has a very creative side, say she is a painter, you will probably view her as a creative person more than noticing her relatively dull traits. (The detail-oriented traits reflect your 4, and the creative aspects describe the 9.)

The 9 is a sophisticated, somewhat aloof number which some people misread as indifference (although this is far from the truth). It is your Heart's Desire number, or the "inner" you. It is compassionate, tolerant, and intelligent. You likely relate easily to people of all countries, cultures, and races. Learning multiple languages is a great advantage to those with a 9 Heart's Desire.

A prejudiced 9 is rare, which is why we find many of them in medicine and law. The 9 is drawn to large institutions, projects, and corporations. Your Heart's Desire number describes what you like and dislike, and reveals what makes you truly happy. A 9 in this position indicates you will likely be most comfortable in this type of environment.

You have additional influences as well. Your 4 Expression describes your talents, abilities, and shortcomings, especially as they relate to your career and productive life. Your 4 Personality is the aspect of your character others notice when you first meet. It is your "outer" more surface reflection. Carrying a 4 in these positions makes you disciplined and well organized. The 4 is a careful planner who can work toward goals in a patient, methodical manner with absolute determination. You probably like to control everything down to the smallest detail, and have your future meticulously planned out.

In combination, the qualities of your 9 Heart's Desire and 4 Expression produce a complicated individual with a tendency to be underestimated. It may be difficult for people to get to know you, because the 4 can be a little stodgy and dull socially, and

the 9 is a bit aloof. The combination can create distance. With awareness of this tendency, you can make an effort to connect with people on the deeper level that you possess, but do not easily reveal.

The 9 also has a creative, artistic side, especially with combining colors, textures, and materials. Architects, fashion designers, furniture makers, ceramicists, landscapers (a particularly good fit for the earthy 4) and those in construction often have the 9 in a prominent place in their chart. In your case, with the focused and grounded 4 in two places anything that requires working with your hands, from surgeon to hairstylist, will suit you. Find an activity that is repetitive and routine to keep you centered, but something that is also creative. This could be part of your profession or a hobby.

In your personal life, romantic relationships may be a challenge. Not only do people tend to misread you, your expectations might not always be realistic. (You may feel you can give more than you actually can.) However, once a relationship is established, whether romantic or platonic, it will likely be for life.



Your Expression Number

Your Expression number, calculated from your full name at birth, reveals the orientation or goal of your life. Some numerologists refer to this as your Destiny number because it represents a lifelong target at which you are aiming. Thus, the Expression number, to some extent, reveals the person you aim to be.

Your Expression is the most influential of the three characteristics that make up who you are. It is also the number with the most influence on your choice of career, although other aspects are important as well.

Your Expression is 31/4

You are the bedrock of society, the foundation of any enterprise. You are an organizer and manager. Your approach to life and to problems is methodical and systematic. You are a builder and a doer. You turn dreams into reality. You possess a highly developed sense of structure. You enjoy management systems, and can carry out your well laid plans. You are not the type to embark on any trip without a map.

You take your obligations and those of your family quite seriously. As a result, you are reliable and responsible. You enjoy seeing a project through from start to finish, but can become too narrowly focused. You put your nose to the grindstone and have a tendency to become a workaholic. You are driven by contempt for all that is unstable, insecure, and unpredictable. You distrust the unconventional, preferring instead the tried-and-the-true. But this can make your endeavors move slowly and cause you much frustration, especially with the apparent limitations of your resources. At the same time, concern for the limitations of your resources causes you to be careful and cautious, shutting you out from possible shortcuts and creative solutions provided by more daring people around you. It is important that you recognize restrictions for what they are: guiding forces that are testing and directing you toward your goals. Your challenge is to be more imaginative and to attract more creative people into your life who can advise and inspire you.

In relationships, you tend to be somewhat moralistic. You are extremely honest and sincere. You have integrity and are trustworthy, but can also be rigid and stubborn. Don't let your strong likes and dislikes overrule your common sense and compassion. Be more understanding of others' shortcomings.

Because you tend to focus on details, you can fall into a rut and become a little dull and overly serious. Often, people born with the 4 Expression need to lighten up and have more fun. You have a keen eye for detail. You have great stamina and can work conscientiously and persistently toward your goals. This eventually brings you success and standing in your community.

In your conservative and careful way, you are good with money. You are very conscious of the balance between income and expenditures. You can limit your expenditures; saving money is important to you.

You are a surprisingly good parent, and love to be involved with children. Somehow, you relate a little more than others to the innocence of children, perhaps seeing a good deal of yourself in them. You, too, are idealistic and respect the simplicity of children.

Many accountants, bookkeepers, government officials, managers, and lawyers are born under the 4 Expression. You can be attracted to the arts and music, but will likely bring your love of structure and order to any artistic field. Classical music and opera are particularly appealing and inspiring for you.



Your Heart's Desire Number

The Expression number described above points to a more productive side of your life. Your Heart's Desire reflects a deeper, inner you; it suggests an underlying urge, your true motivation, and the general intention behind many of your actions. It reveals the environment and lifestyle you prefer, as well as your likes, dislikes, and the type of people you are drawn to. Consequently, it dramatically influences the choices you make in life.

It makes sense that the vowels of your name are the foundation for your Heart's Desire. Vowels are the peaks and valleys of a language. Notice how vowels leave your mouth in a free-flowing breath. Try it: Aaaa.... Eeee.... Oooo.. Consonants though, are cut off either at the beginning or in the end. You might say that it is in the flow of your breath that you express your deeper self.

Your Heart's Desire is 18/9

You want to be of service to the world. Your deepest satisfaction comes from knowing that you have advanced the cause of humanity. Your ideals are of the highest order. You are a perfectionist. You strive to make the world a utopia; to make each person's

lot in life better; to become perfect yourself. One of your challenges in life is to strive toward your lofty goals and at the same time recognize the good you are doing.

You like and are fascinated by people from all walks of life. Human nature is a lifelong study for you. You are highly intuitive, but not an especially good judge of character. You are a bit naive, as well, thinking perhaps that all people have the same values as you. You dream of having the resources to immediately relieve the suffering of others, whether it is economic, physical, or psychological. You are gifted with a good mind and a great deal of wisdom, which makes you a natural teacher, counselor, or healer.

As much as you desire to be of service to others, you also crave fame and the approval of the masses. Much of the energy you expend in life is directed toward putting yourself before an audience, most often as a salesperson whose product provides some social good; as a philanthropist; or an artist. You are attracted to the arts as a vocation, especially as an actor, photographer, or writer. It is the paradox of your Heart's Desire that you receive by giving. Both your material success and spiritual satisfaction are made possible through service and sacrifice to others.



Your Personality Number

The consonants of your full name at birth are the foundation of your Personality number, which is a little like a narrow entrance hall to the great room that is your true nature. It's the outer layer of your personality, the part you feel more or less comfortable sharing. With time and trust, you invite others into the deeper aspects of your nature.

Your Personality number serves as a censoring device in terms of what you send out, as well as whom and what you allow to approach. For this reason, your Personality is usually much more narrow and protective in its definition than the real you. It also gives an indication of how others perceive you.

Your Personality number is 13/4

You radiate reliability and consistency. People trust you and feel secure with your judgment. You are seen as a cornerstone of a business and are relied upon to do your work efficiently and expertly. You have strength and respectability. You tend to dress in a utilitarian manner, concerned mostly with convention, practicality, durability, and price. All of this stems from the fact that your most prized characteristic is your work. You want to be judged on the basis of your performance, rather than your appearance. You are frugal and have learned to respect a dollar. You are concerned about the security of

your future and those you love. However, this may appear to others as a bit too austere.

You tend to wear earth colors and conventional attire. You could benefit by putting a little flair in your dress. Wear more uplifting colors. Loosen your dress with less severe lines. If you wear a brown suit, include a bright tie or some jewelry.

You are a family person. You love the intimacy, consistency, and the security a family provides. You are a good provider and protector. But family members may take your efforts for granted.

Your Heart's Desire and Personality Bridge Number

A Bridge number is based on the numerical difference between two closely related aspects in your chart. It is the gap you need to "bridge" in order to create a more harmonious bond between the two areas.

The following Bridge number connects your Heart's Desire and Personality numbers. It suggests things you can do to help your deeper self be more closely aligned with your personality, the "outer" you that is apparent to others.

With a little exaggeration, you could say that your Personality number is somewhat like your mask; it's a more superficial aspect you reveal to the world. You can imagine how much more comfortable and less inhibited the experience of life becomes when you can align your authentic self with the personality you show to the world.

Your Heart's Desire/Personality Bridge is 5

You need to be more flexible and adaptable. Be willing to go out on a limb; be adventurous and unconventional. Be tolerant and flexible. Accept changes. Rigid ideas and dogmas may keep you from reaching out and following your dreams. Make freedom a high priority in your life.

The Path You Are On

If there was ever a moment of transformation, it was the moment of your birth. In that instant, you stepped into a new reality - the reality of human life and human consciousness. Even at that moment you were a person with your own unique character, as unique as your DNA.

The previous chapters focused on YOU, the person you are, as revealed in the letters of your name. It is now time to look at your Path, the road you walk through life, using the numbers found in your date of birth.

Your first breath marked the beginning of your journey on the road we call your Life Path. It makes sense, then, that the most important number in your numerology chart comes from the date of your birth.

Your Life Path number gives a broad outline of the opportunities, challenges, and lessons you encounter throughout your life. It also reveals the strengths, specific talents, and characteristics you were given to help you overcome challenges and evolve into the best you can be.



Your Life Path Number

Your Life Path number is considered the single most significant information available in your Personality Chart. It is derived from the total of all numbers found in your date of birth. However, it is important to keep in mind that the aspects described in the next few chapters will either complement, supplement, or sometimes weaken the attributes revealed in numbers derived from your name.

Your Life Path is 19/1

You are a born leader. You insist on your right to make up your own mind; you demand freedom of thought and action. You have drive and determination. You don't let anything or anyone stand in your way once you are committed to your goal. You assume the responsibility to be the protector and provider for those you love. You demand respect and attention and become irritated and even domineering when important things do not go your way. You need to feel in command of important undertakings, and resist supportive roles. You seek the forefront and the limelight. You are very concerned with your status and foster the appearance of success and self-satisfaction. The need to appear well off propels you to strive for growth, success and the finer things of life.

You are exceptionally creative and original and possess a touch of the unusual. Your approach to problems is unique and you have the courage to wander from the beaten path. You can be impatient with your shortcomings and those of others.

You should watch out for selfishness, conceit and the over-concern with appearance. You must guard against overzealous behavior, anger and aggressiveness. If these qualities are not brought under control you could become excessively domineering, vindictive and even violent. You perform best when you are left to your own devices. Ideally you should own your own business and be your own boss. Hold fast to your life's dream and work with the determination you possess to realize it. You can become overly stressed by your driven nature. Be careful about the food you eat and maintain an exercise program you enjoy. Competition sports are often a healthy outlet for a person with your drive, particularly sports involving running and swimming. Don't let pride and overconfidence be your masters. Remember, your talents and abilities are a gift from a higher source, which should promote gratitude and humility, rather than pride and conceit.

More often than not a person with a 1 Life Path will achieve much in life as long as the drive, creativity, originality and pioneering spirit are fully employed!

Your Life Path number is 1, based on 19 ($1 + 9 = 10$, $1 + 0 = 1$), which is a Karmic Debt number. (The 13, 14, 16, and 19 are Karmic Debt numbers.) Although identical in many

ways to the Life Path numbers 1 and 10, the person with the 19 Karmic Debt will learn independence and the proper use of power through trial and error. You will be forced to stand up for yourself, and often be left to stand alone. Difficulties will be faced and overcome through personal struggle. One of the central lessons for people with the 19 Karmic Debt is that you stubbornly resist help. Much of your independence is self-imposed; you simply don't want to listen to others, or accept the help or advice of others. Your 19 Karmic Debt can become a self-imposed prison if you do not open up to the reality of interdependence, and the mutual need for love.

The most important lesson for the 19 Karmic Debt is: While you seek to stand on your own feet, you are still a human being, deeply connected with others and in need of the support, assistance, and human understanding that all people need. Those with the 19 Karmic Debt will learn the hard way that "no man is an island," and that we are, indeed, "all bits of the main!"



Your Birth Day Number

The day you were born is found inside the diamond-shape in your personal chart, and bears great significance in understanding who you are and where your talents lie. Your day of birth indicates special talents you possess. It gives us an indication of the approach you will take toward the goals, opportunities and obstacles you encounter on your Life's Path.

Your Birth Day number is 3

You have a highly-developed creative talent. You are an artist at heart. You could excel in writing, visual, or performing arts. If you are not professionally involved in one of these areas, you should consider taking up art as a hobby. You are highly-imaginative, quick-witted, and possess the gift of gab. affectionate and loving. You possess a good deal of charisma. You can also be moody and subject to rapid ups and downs.

Your Life Path and Birth Day Bridge Number

Your Life Path and Birthday numbers are closely connected and influence each other. This Bridge explains how you can make the connection between them more harmonious.

Your Life Path/ Birthday Bridge is 7

Your Life Path and Birth Day numbers indicate that few things hamper your progress as much as becoming overly emotional. Feelings are the most valuable aspect of being human and they should not be stifled. However, when they become a burden to the extent that they obscure your clarity and ability to function, it is necessary to moderate your emotions. 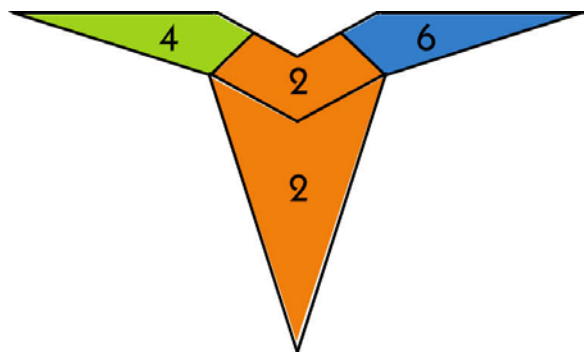
Your Challenges

You face four specific Challenges in your lifetime. For many of us, the same challenge is repeated, while others have four distinctly different lessons to learn.

These Challenges place you in situations that require you to face the particular lesson at hand. This provides an opportunity for you to learn or better integrate personal traits that will benefit you during the lesson, and throughout your life.

The four Challenges in your chart will influence you during the periods of your life listed

below. They are found within the lower half of the star-shape in your numerology chart. The First Challenge is shown on the left, the Second Challenge on the right, the Main or Third Challenge is placed in the middle, and the Fourth Challenge is located below that.



Your First Challenge

The duration of your First Challenge usually lasts from birth until age 30 to 35.

Your First Challenge number is 4

You must learn to discriminate between iron balloons and those that will fly. You have difficulty finishing projects because your vision becomes chaotic and loses track of the path ahead.

You have the ability to be practical and organized but you must learn their value. This will cause you to incorporate them into your daily life and give you the basis for success.

Your Third or Main Challenge

Your Third Challenge number is 2

Your Path and You

We have focused on the letters of your name and the numbers from your date of birth. We will now look at numbers in your chart derived from the combination of both your name and the date of your birth.

Acquiring the attributes described in the next few chapters will help smooth your progress. As you learn more about yourself, you may begin to recognize traits you were previously unaware of.

Your Life Path and Expression Bridge Number

This Bridge has the potential to "close the gap" between the Life Path and the Expression numbers. The chapter explains how you can make your talents, strengths, and specific abilities (your Expression number) more readily available and fitting to your main lesson needs, as well as the expected direction of your growth (your Life Path).

The scope and influence of the Expression Bridge is narrower and more defined than

the other Bridge numbers. Its effect will be felt primarily in your professional life, including your position as household/family manager, if that is your primary work.

For those with few fives, the increasing ability to adapt to change and the willingness to take risks provides much spice to life.

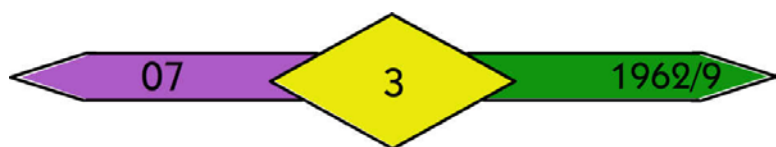
Your Period Cycles

Like most stories, there are three distinct stages of your life. Your First, Second, and Third Period Cycles come from your month, day, and year of birth respectively. Together they form the foundation of your Life's Path.

The First Cycle, located on the left of the graphic, begins in childhood and lasts through your late 20's. It's a quest for knowledge and identity while you cope with the powerful forces that are present in your environment. These forces include your parents and the socio-economic conditions of your family, for example.

The Second Cycle is found inside the diamond-shape and covers the middle period of your life, bringing about the slow emergence of your individual and creative talents. This cycle begins in the early and mid-30's while struggling to find your place in the world. The late 30's, 40's, and 50's, bring a greater degree of self-mastery and influence over your environment.

The Third Cycle, on the right of the graphic, starts approximately age 55, and represents a flowering of your inner self as your true nature comes to fruition. It is during this period that you have the greatest degree of power and self-expression.

Your First Period Cycle number is 7

A time to specialize, a time to think deeply and contemplate the deeper questions of life. Study a subject you enjoy in depth. Tom, you are attracted to the fields of science, technology, philosophy, and metaphysics. Become an expert in a specific area. You have excellent intuition and a mind that can penetrate beneath the surface of any subject you commit to. Focus your energies and thoughts. This is a period of inner development. Your Second Period Cycle

Your Second Period Cycle runs from your mid 30's until your late 50's.

Your Third Period Cycle

Your Third Period Cycle covers the later part of your life, starting in your early 60's.

The latter part of your life finds you increasingly idealistic and concerned with the betterment of humankind. You become more broadminded and reach out to people from all walks of life. You offer your time and resources to causes you believe in. Your interests are increasingly directed toward other cultures and societies. Your sense of justice and your interest in political and humanitarian issues becomes more finely tuned. Whereas most people "mellow out" with age, you find yourself becoming more passionate.

Your creativity increases during the latter part of your life, with a focus on design and large-scale projects. You may be inspired to study design, engineering, or architecture.

Your Pinnacle Cycles

Although Pinnacle Cycles and Period Cycles are both derived from your date of birth, they differ in the way you experience them. Period Cycles, described above, reflect internal stages of growth. Pinnacle Cycles represent the external influences you encounter in life.

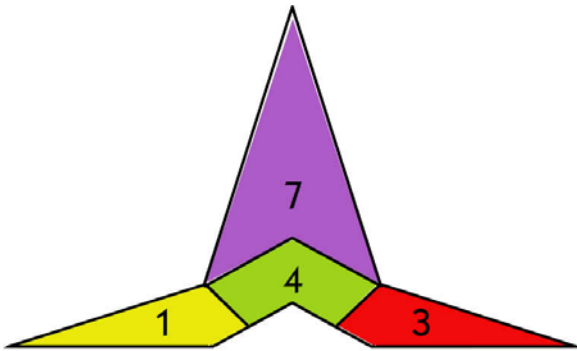
Pinnacles reveal general conditions and events you experience during each period, such as your environment, social conditions, relationships, and changing circumstances. Pinnacles reveal how you might respond to these influences and how they will affect your ever-evolving personality.

The First Pinnacle. located in the left of the star-shape in your chart, usually lasts from birth through age 30 to 35. The middle two Pinnacles, to the right and the center respectively, each last nine years. The Fourth Pinnacle, placed in the top section, will stay with you for the remainder of your life.

NOTE: To find the exact age at which you change cycles, go to worldnumerology.com and look for the Pinnacle widget about half way down the home page. A future update to the app will include the ages right here.

The transition from one Pinnacle to the next is usually strongly felt. You begin to feel the transition from one Pinnacle to the next approximately two years in advance. The latter part of that two-year period can be particularly strong. You will likely make life-altering decisions, such as marriage, a job or career change, or major changes in your personal makeup.

Knowing and understanding your approaching Pinnacle number prepares you for the changes ahead. Perhaps the most strongly felt change is the transition from First to Second Pinnacle, which usually takes place in your late 20's or early 30's (the exact date depends on your Life Path number). This is usually a difficult transition but once crossed, provides a clear sense of direction and a firmer sense of identity.



Your First Pinnacle Cycle

This is usually the most strongly felt Pinnacle Cycle and runs from birth until age 36 minus your Life Path number (single digit). For example, if your Life Path is 12/3, deduct 3 from 36.

Your First Pinnacle cycle number is 1

You must continually put out effort, but with it comes great reward. Without it, there is no accomplishment nor satisfaction, only a negative attitude toward life. The benefit of this Pinnacle number is a strong sense of your individuality and strength. You will know what you are made of. There are many hidden gifts in this period, perhaps the greatest of which is faith. Your Pinnacle provides you with the characteristics of

Your Second Pinnacle Cycle

Your Second Pinnacle Cycle lasts nine years and tends to have a considerable influence on your productive/professional life.

This is a time of specialization. You will pursue some course of development with fervor and focus. Your ability to concentrate will be greatly increased. Your desire to study in all forms -- reading, self-reflection, and contemplation -- will reach an all-time high. Your intuition is much more sensitive, making your path a little easier and more direct, since you know intuitively the appropriate next step.

Under this Pinnacle, you will become an expert in one particular field. Your capacity to penetrate the depths of a subject area is enormous. You will look below the surface in virtually everything you encounter. It is very possible that you will find yourself in a teaching role.

You must consciously work on your closer relationships, especially with your spouse and children.
