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Life Path

Your Life Path number is considered the single most significant information available in your Personality Chart. It is derived from the total of all numbers found in your date of birth. However, it is important to keep in mind that the aspects described in the next few chapters will either complement, supplement, or sometimes weaken the attributes revealed in numbers derived from your name.

Expression

Your combination of numbers in this part of the chart is particularly interesting. If the relationship began recently and has already experienced considerable ups and downs, you might be in for a very rough ride. Like a kaleidoscope, the mind of the 3 easily changes color and shape and enchants those around it. However, the 3 also prefers to stay on the surface, keeping things light and upbeat.

Personality

Maturity Number

Your Maturity's Compatibility is 1 and 4

This aspect of the chart reveals a combination that can be as solid as a rock for a long period only to crash and burn in an instant. Stubborn, highly motivated, a self-starter and an unconventional individualist, Anthony is adventurous and ready to try anything new, even risky endeavors. Strongly driven, people with the number 1 are not usually concerned about other's expectations. Anthony generally does whatever he wants and will fight almost anyone who gets in the way. Mary is no less gifted in the areas of persistence and ambition, but has a very different attitude and approach. Mary is influenced by the number 4 which is sturdy, reliable, patient, responsible, conventional, detail-oriented, and "does things the right way". This difference is precisely where potential pitfalls lie in your relationship.

Mary has both feet planted firmly on the ground. Undeterred by the prospect of dealing with things that are boring or routine, Mary will complete the job no matter what. Anthony, on the other hand, does not have that kind of patience; he will barge ahead unconcerned about the consequences

Your relationship has the ability to thrive unless Anthony starts down a
