

ABOUT YOUR RELATIONSHIP PROFILE

This report analyzes the personalities of both subjects to assess their compatibility. It also offers suggestions for ways to mitigate the stress or damage that can come from differing personalities and perspectives.

Ignoring potential issues can cause more damage in the long run than a few honest remarks in a reading.

You will probably encounter some texts that state: "The compatibility aspect in this area of the chart is already included in other parts of this report." Those texts are not repeated here because they are either redundant or offset by other conditions. This is done to offer a perspective that is as well balanced and clear as possible; repeating certain traits would place too much emphasis on them.

If you have received previous reports that mentioned double-digit numbers in your chart, such as Master numbers or Karmic Debt numbers, you will notice in the Relationship Compatibility Reports all numbers are reduced to single digits. This is because single digit numbers are the essential influences that affect relationship compatibility; including double-digit numbers would only diminish the clarity we aim for.

I hope you will appreciate the perspective of your Compatibility Report and will find it beneficial to your relationship.

THE LIFE PATH

Your Life Path number is considered the single most significant information available in your Personality Chart. It is derived from the total of all numbers found in your date of birth. However, it is important to keep in mind that the aspects described in the next few chapters will either complement, supplement, or sometimes weaken the attributes revealed in numbers derived from your name.

Mary, your Life Path number is 8



You are gifted with natural leadership and the capacity to accumulate great wealth. You have great talent for management in all areas of life, especially in business and financial matters. You understand the material world; you intuitively know what makes virtually any enterprise work. Your talent lies not with the bookkeeping or petty management, but with the greater vision, its purpose, and long-range goals. You are a visionary and a bit

reckless.

You possess the ability to inspire people to join you in your quest, but often they are incapable of seeing what you see. Therefore, those around you need your continual guidance, inspiration, and encouragement. You must prod them into action and direct them along the lines of your vision.

You attract financial success more than any other Life Path, but effort is required. Your challenge in life is to achieve a high degree of detachment, to understand that power and influence must be used for the benefit of mankind. Those born with the Number 8 Life Path, who do not understand the real and relative value of money are bound to suffer the consequences of greed; they run the risk of losing it all!

You must learn to bounce back from failures and defeats. You have the character and resilience of a true survivor. It is not uncommon for a person with your Life Path to experience major reverses, including bankruptcies, financial failure, but you also have the talent and the sheer guts to make more than one fortune, and build many successful enterprises. More than most people, your failures in marriage can be extremely expensive for you.

Despite the difficulties that life presents, you will experience the satisfaction that comes from material wealth and the power that comes with it. Business, finance, real estate, law, science (particularly history, archeology, and physics), publishing, and the management of large institutions are among the vocational fields that suit you best. You are naturally attracted to positions of influence and leadership -- Politics, social work, and teaching are among the many other areas where your abilities can shine. You are a good judge of character, which aids you well in attracting the right people to you.

Most 8s like large families and sometimes tend to keep others dependent longer than necessary. Although

jovial in nature you are not demonstrative in showing your love and affection.

The desire for luxury and comfort is especially strong in you. Status is very important. You must be careful to avoid living above your means.

Your Life Path treads that dangerous ground where power lies -- and can corrupt. You may become too self-important, arrogant, and domineering, thinking that your way is the only way. This leads inevitably to isolation and conflict. The people you run the risk of hurting most are those you love, your family and friends.

Be careful of becoming stubborn, intolerant, overbearing, and impatient. These characteristics may be born early in the life of an 8 Life Path, who often learn these negative traits after suffering under a tyrannical parent or a family burdened by repressive religious or intellectual dogmas.

Those with the 8 Life Path usually possess a strong physique, which is a symptom of their inherent strength and resiliency.

Peter, your Life Path number is 9



You are the philanthropist, humanitarian, socially conscious, and are deeply concerned about the state of the world. You have great compassion and idealism. You are a utopian and will spend your life trying to realize some aspect of your utopian dream, sacrificing money, time, and energy for a better world. It is in giving that you will find much satisfaction.

You have a broad outlook on life. You tend to see the big picture, rather than the minute details. You naturally attract people from all walks of life who can fit into your larger plans and take over the areas you find uninteresting. The person with a 9 Life Path is rarely prejudiced or accepts social biases of people. Instead, they evaluate people on the basis of what they can do for the larger cause. They are the true egalitarian.

You are imaginative and creative, especially at harmoniously arranging the beauty already potential in the environment. These abilities can lead you into such fields as interior decorating, landscape art, and photography. But because of your strong social consciousness, you can be an effective politician, lawyer, judge, minister, teacher, healer, and environmentalist. Vocations that require self- sacrifice and have a clear social impact are common among 9s.

You are often disappointed by the realities of life: the shortcomings of others, or of yourself. Somehow, you don't want to accept the imperfections of the world, a feeling that drives you constantly to try to improve upon it. But rather than be satisfied with your efforts, and those of others, you relentlessly push on, striving

for greater accomplishments. You are often unsatisfied with the results. In short, you lack the perspective that would otherwise make it possible for you to enjoy life more fully and accept its natural limitations. You have a controlled enthusiasm and the ability to finish what you start.

A key to your personality is the necessity of sacrifice. You have to learn to let go of material possessions and relationships, the inherent lesson being that holding on too tightly to anything causes pain. Money comes to you through mysterious or unexpected ways: inheritance; the benevolence of someone who was inspired by your work; or a lucky investment. Conversely, if you pursue money for its own sake, after giving up on your larger dreams, you're likely to find yourself empty handed.

The most successful and satisfying road for a nine is giving; sharing and sacrificing for a larger goal, without expecting anything in return. Your greatest chance at success is to tie your personal fortunes to an endeavor that makes the world a better place for others. Very often, this turns into a highly successful and lucrative enterprise, providing amply for you and your family. Your life rests on the axiom that the more you give, the bigger your reward.

You are romantic, but your love is more impersonal. You tend to be focused on your dreams.

When you are not in harmony with your true nature, you can fall to moodiness, or become aloof, and withdrawn. You can become timid, uncertain, and ungrateful, putting the blame for your troubles on others or the world. You have a gift for examining your life objectively, and at some distance. Be honest with yourself. By openly facing your shortcomings, as well as your strengths, you develop equilibrium. You are thus able to love and better understand yourself and all of life.

HOW YOUR LIFE PATH NUMBERS COMPARE

Your Life Path number is the most important influence in your chart. As such, their compatibility is very important to the well being of your relationship.

Mary and Peter, your Life Path Compatibility is 8 and 9

Mary and Peter, this part of the chart reveals two numbers at opposite ends of the spectrum. The 8 and 9 have almost nothing in common and are not considered compatible, yet they are often strongly attracted to each other. Interestingly, this attraction can remain compelling and fresh for many years because there is always something new to discover in each other.

A go-getter with big dreams and expectations, Mary (the 8) has a good chance to turn many of those dreams into reality because She is highly motivated and willing to put forth enormous effort to reach a goal. It is the nature of the 8 to direct energy toward accumulating wealth and power, so for Mary, this is natural and

healthy.

Peter is equally focused but driven by completely different priorities and motives. The 9 in his chart is motivated by the work itself and the way it affects the lives of others, rather than financial gain or material success. The 9 will rarely find happiness or achieve success if motivated by worldly desires; Peter finds personal reward when driven by humanitarian motives.

Obviously, your priorities are as different as night and day, yet both are as they should be. You will often find yourselves at opposite sides of a discussion and will rarely agree when it comes to practical matters. For a happy relationship, you will both need to recognize and respect your differences. If you take each other for granted or begin to feel you can predict and control your partner, your relationship will be in trouble. The keyword in this relationship is respect. If you respect each other, disagreements - of which there will probably be many - will not weaken your foundation.

THE EXPRESSION

Your Expression number, calculated from your full name at birth, reveals the orientation or goal of your life. Some numerologists refer to this as your Destiny number because it represents a lifelong target at which you are aiming. Thus, the Expression number, to some extent, reveals the person you aim to be.

Your Expression is the most influential of the three characteristics that make up who you are. It is also the number with the most influence on your choice of career, although other aspects are important as well.

Mary, your Expression is 7



You are gifted with an analytical mind and an enormous appetite for the answers to life's hidden questions. You have a strong interest in exploring scientific matters, philosophy, and even mysticism. You possess clarity and persistence in your search for truth. You can be a great researcher, educator, and philosopher. You are driven by a desire for knowledge and truth. You must learn to discriminate between illusion and reality, but you are well

equipped for this task. Your fine mind offers insight into the veiled mysteries of life. You also possess a considerable amount of perspective. Somewhere inside you, you are aware of a peaceful place that you call upon during difficult times.

You need time to be by yourself. Too much social interaction causes you stress. You need your privacy and a place that can be shut off from the hustle and bustle of life. You tend to keep your thoughts to yourself and are secretive. Unless your 7 expression is balanced by extrovert characteristics (usually revealed by the numbers 1, 3, 5, and 8), your introversion may pull you deeply within yourself, even cutting you off from others.

You have a strong dislike of the superficial and mundane. You are often surprised by the lack of understanding or depth of knowledge of others, many of whom do not take the search for knowledge as seriously as you do. This can cause you to be critical of others, and even cynical about life in general. The more cut off from others you become, the more hidden are your motives. Once you develop understanding of people and life, your advice and counsel will be sought by those around you who need your wisdom.

You love to specialize your knowledge and develop great depth within your field. You are a perfectionist. You should complete your studies early in life and not be driven too hard by a desire to be successful. Let things come at their own pace, be open to opportunity, but remember your rewards, satisfaction, and contentment come from a higher source.

Sevens can be distant and aloof. When dominated by their darker characteristics, they can be unfaithful, dishonest, and cruel. Contemplation, meditation, and the softer, finer vibrations of life can restore your sense of harmony and keep you on the path to peace and balance.

You have a logical mind. Your analytical skills cause you to approach a problem in a detached, surgical kind of way. Researchers, analysts, investigators, inventors, technicians, scholars, lawyers, bankers, watchmakers, priests, philosophers, theologians, and administrators in some scientific or technical field are among the vocations 7s are drawn to.

Peter, your Expression is 7

HOW YOUR EXPRESSION NUMBERS COMPARE

More than any other number in your chart, your Expression number reflects who you are as a whole person on a deep level (rather than the "face" you show to the world, described by your Personality number).

It cannot be over-emphasized how important it is to recognize that the same number in a different area of your chart will affect you differently. There may be times you read something that seems to directly contradict an earlier statement. Yet, if you take time to carefully think about the opposing information you might recognize that, being the complex individual you are, you carry the same contradictions. This is natural and true for all of us. You may excel at organization in one area of your life, while chaos rules in another. You may be tactful and sensitive in one setting, but direct and confrontational in another.

Be aware that it is more difficult to overcome negative traits you recognize in yourself when they are found in this part of the chart, than when they are found under the Life Path description.

Mary and Peter, your Expression Compatibility is 7 and 7

Mary and Peter, yours is a beautiful combination, with great potential for spiritual growth. You both appreciate life and life's mysteries deeply. You have a strong intellectual and spiritual bond and thrive on each other's intellect and wisdom.

The relationship between the 2 and 7 may begin in the heart, but it quickly moves to the inner realms. The term "soul mates" applies to couples that share the 7 in this part of the chart. Poets at heart - even if you have never written a poem in your life - you intuitively recognize that your bond with each other is spiritual in nature and more valuable than anything else in your lives. You grow together, without the need to constantly be together. You probably communicate in half sentences and often find yourself thinking or expressing the same thing your partner just said.

If your relationship is moving toward maturity, you are likely to be joined at the hip. Having said that, there are also things to watch for to avoid spoiling such a beautiful relationship. No other number can, at times, become as stubborn and unforgiving (even in small matters). In extreme cases, the 7 can become small-minded, even neurotic. While rare, a tendency to allow a minor issue to become a major disagreement does exist. What is interesting is, important issues rarely cause the same reaction; the 7 is too intelligent to be petty. But the same person who can lead a study group with insight and the ability to communicate even the most arcane concepts, can turn into a hair splitter when it comes to seemingly minor household issues.

Mary and Peter, there is one issue you should be particularly aware of, as it has the potential to destroy this otherwise excellent combination. You both enjoy a highly imaginative inner life. Consequently, you need time alone for study, contemplation, or just to let your mind wander. When your living space is too small, or you lead hectic lives continually surrounded by others (even each other) your need for quiet personal space will begin to take precedence over everything else. It is not uncommon for people with a 7 in this part of the chart to leave a promising career, relationship, or family due to this inner need.

It is important that you both find a way to honor this and create an environment where you can have time alone. If you become aware of underlying tension building, talk to your partner and discuss solutions. Recognize your common need to share your life and ideas while maintaining your individuality and need for personal time.

THE HEART'S DESIRE

The Expression number described above points to a more productive side of your life. Your Heart's Desire

reflects a deeper, inner you; it suggests an underlying urge, your true motivation, and the general intention behind many of your actions. It reveals the environment and lifestyle you prefer, as well as your likes, dislikes, and the type of people you are drawn to. Consequently, it dramatically influences the choices you make in life.

It makes sense that the vowels of your name are the foundation for your Heart's Desire. Vowels are the peaks and valleys of a language. Notice how vowels leave your mouth in a free-flowing breath. Try it: Aaaa.... Eeee.... Oooo.. Consonants though, are cut off either at the beginning or in the end.

You might say that it is in the flow of your breath that you express your deeper self.

Mary, your Heart's Desire number is 7

You love knowledge, study, and insight. You value the gifts of your mind, which you use to great advantage to penetrate the mysteries of life. You study things in-depth. You search beneath the surface of things. You abhor shallow judgments or opinions.

You have a natural gift for analysis and research. Once you have grasped the facts of a subject, your creativity and abstract approach lifts your thinking beyond the rudimentary to the philosophical. You have a theoretical mind, but rather than indulge in fantasies or idle thought, you prefer to base your theories upon scientific facts. You enjoy mental and physical puzzles -- figuring them out, taking them apart, and putting them back together.

Some people may perceive you as cool or aloof. You are somewhat introverted; you may feel slightly removed and even a little different. The fantasy of the hermit or monk engaged in a life of study and meditation appeals to you.

In relationships, you tend to keep things business-like and impersonal. You prefer to talk about the facts of a given situation, rather than the cloudier issues of emotions and personal feelings. You distrust feelings -- both your own and those of others. The whole emotional realm strikes you as unreliable, and a bit unnecessary. Your inability to fully understand the emotional aspect of life is your Achilles heel. You are so rational that the unpredictability of the heart frightens and surprises you.

Your challenge is to trust. You need to share your heart with someone. This is a courageous step for you but will result in enormous growth and satisfaction.

The advice here is to make a true connection with another human being. Without it, you may marry out of convenience or to fulfill social expectations, but it will not lead you out of loneliness. The more removed you are from people, the more you risk isolation, bitterness, and a cynical attitude toward life. This choice

represents a true crossroads in your development. By sharing yourself with others (without compromising your independence and need for privacy) you can cultivate your enormous charm and share your understanding of life. You are a natural teacher and advisor. And the wealth of knowledge you will accumulate in life is meant to be shared with others.

This is not to say that you must compromise on your need for privacy or time spent alone to contemplate life. These are natural aspects of your personality, which are essential to your growth. These characteristics should not be threatening to your spouse but must be understood as fundamental to your being.

You are blessed with a great reserve of intuition, which can be cultivated by regular meditation and contemplation. Your "inner voice" is your greatest guide and friend. You are idealistic and have high expectations for yourself. Learn to balance your serious nature with regular doses of fun. Your intelligence and cultivation make you charming and distinguished in appearance. As you get older and more comfortable with your identity, people are naturally attracted to you. They see your wisdom, your deep understanding of life, and the refinement you radiate.

Peter, your Heart's Desire number is 8



You want success in its fullest meaning -- wealth, power, and material comforts. You have an enormous ambition. You dream of big projects, great undertakings, and rewards. You are a visionary. You see the horizon and the promise. In general, you also see the methods necessary to fulfill that promise. But you are not especially good with details; you need others to help you deal with the smaller parts of the picture.

Your challenge is to make full use of the full spectrum of your abilities, as indicated by your other core numbers. In the same way, you must bring forth the best from others and orchestrate their talents toward the realization of your vision. In short, you must lead by example, demonstrating the standard for commitment, determination, and excellence.

All of this requires effort on your part. You will meet with obstacles and difficulties. Your determination and commitment will be tested. But you have the power to overcome every obstacle you face and accomplish the goal you've set for yourself.

Your task in life is to learn to use power in refined and elevated ways. The expression and use of power are directly related to one's personal evolution. The more primitive uses of power rest with violence and the threat of deprivation. The higher expressions depend upon your capacity to care for and nourish the people and projects in your charge, giving each exactly what is needed at the appropriate time and in appropriate amounts.

You have a creative mind and an unusual approach to business and problem-solving. You need to cultivate

your ability to evaluate others. It is essential for you to be involved in a project that challenges you and offers the potential for rewards. When you are uninvolved or unoccupied with a worthwhile task, you can become deeply despondent, depressed, and frustrated. You are the perfect example of the old platitude, "Idle hands are the devil's workshop."

Without a challenge, you can lose balance in life and become selfish, cruel, and even self-destructive. Disappointments become shattering, causing terrible consequences in self-image and self-love. Perspective is everything for you. You have a natural talent for balancing the spiritual and material planes.

You need to cultivate courage and stamina. Courage is a choice. You need to decide to be brave in the face of fear. A balanced 8 is among the most powerful and satisfying of numbers. It is the spirit of the true survivor, able to bounce back and achieve a greater victory.

HOW YOUR HEART'S DESIRE NUMBERS COMPARE

Compatibility of the Heart's Desire number is very important in a relationship. Few relationships last beyond the initial stage if these numbers are not harmonious.

Mary and Peter, your Heart's Desire Compatibility is 7 and 8

Mary and Peter, this combination indicates your relationship is most likely supported by other numbers and influences in your chart, rather than the 7 and 8 found in this area. The 7 and 8 are usually not attracted to each other or particularly compatible in romantic relationships. The notion that opposites attract does not often hold true here.

This does not mean you cannot have a fulfilling, well-suited relationship, but simply that other numbers in your chart are likely the source of your mutual attraction. Carrying the 7 and the 8 in this location of your chart, however, suggests you have major differences that could cause problems.

Your priorities differ. This aspect of the chart tells us Peter (the 8) has a strong drive for financial success and security. For Mary, spiritual and intellectual growth is a higher priority. Peter intuitively understands the balance between the material and intangible, which is the reason he excels in business, marketing, or sales. (One must be somewhat detached from material gain to have the vision and clarity it takes to successfully pursue a goal.) Mary moves in the inner realms, and is not intrinsically drawn to business, even deeming it unworthy of attention. She would rather discuss political, philosophical, or spiritual matters, with a preference for the abstract - issues that could seem boring to Peter who prefers a practical, down-to-earth approach that focuses on results.

Similarly, you could find yourselves at opposite ends of the spectrum when it comes to likes and dislikes,


from movies to books, travel to housing, decorating, art, and so forth. Mary might enjoy living in a rather isolated, cozy, country home, while Peter would be happy in a futuristic loft in a large metropolis. The friends you attract will also be quite different. The 7 in Mary's chart points to quiet conversations rather than loud parties. Peter occasionally enjoys an energetic environment and interaction with others.

The potential lack of compatibility between these numbers has nothing to do with the heart. It generally involves practical preferences, such as where to live, how to decorate the house, and who you become friends with. This can be overcome by allowing each other considerable space and freedom in the way you live your lives. You will both need to recognize and accept your differences. Keep in mind there are influences in other areas of your chart that may mitigate some of these contrasts. If so, focus on the things you both enjoy, then allow one another the freedom to express your individuality.

MATURITY NUMBER

Your Maturity number indicates an underlying wish or desire that gradually surfaces at around age 30 to 35. A direction begins to emerge as you gain a better understanding of yourself. With this self-knowledge comes a greater awareness of who you are, and the direction you want to set for your life.

Mary, your Maturity number is 6



As you mature, you will become increasingly concerned with the well-being of family, friends, and community. You will be drawn to the role as healer, counselor, and teacher. You have a growing ability to give comfort and sound advice to those in need. You naturally assume the role of patriarch or matriarch of those in your care, no matter how old they are. You become more responsible and protective. You may well become involved in

environmental protection, volunteer work or politics. You are naturally idealistic and strive to realize those ideals as you grow in maturity and in personal resources.

Your careful and balanced approach to business and financial matters provides you with sound and secure success later in life. The 6-maturity number provides an outstanding financial foundation for the future. In addition, the influence of the 6 promises an old age surrounded by loved ones.

For those who have few 6s in the chart, or none at all, this Maturity Number promises the close relationships that you have striven for most of your life.

Peter, your Maturity number is 7



As you mature, you will become increasingly occupied with the larger questions of life, reading, contemplating and searching for a deeper understanding of who you are and what this life is all about. You may turn to philosophy or religion, but will likely examine a wide array of areas, broadening your knowledge in many disciplines.

Your intuition grows stronger, as does your ability to look beneath the surface of every subject you study. You are able to analyze abstract questions and live according to your higher ideals. You may find yourself needing more time alone; your need for privacy will likely increase.

If you already have several sevens in your chart, you will have to guard against becoming withdrawn, and alienated. If you have no sevens, you will now have the ability to deepen your understanding of one particular field. You will have the opportunity to become grounded in a particular area of study.

HOW YOUR MATURITY NUMBERS COMPARE

Your Maturity number becomes more dominant with age. The texts below become increasingly important after about age 40.

Mary and Peter, your Maturity Compatibility is 6 and 7

The 6 and 7 often have a love-hate relationship, so it is uncommon to find it in romantic partners. Where the 6 is strongly committed and motivated by emotions and a need for romance, the 7 is intellectual and somewhat secretive and distant. Mary (the 6) requires a physical and emotional connection; Peter seeks an intellectual bond. This has nothing to do with the ability or desire to love, since no number is more capable of loving than any other. But challenges can arise when people have dramatically different views or strikingly different approaches to important concerns.

All numbers express love in a different way. Mary's 6 in this part of the chart is mainly influenced by emotions and depends on expressions of love to feel safe and secure in a relationship. Peter's 7 is more independent, which enables him to feel comfortable in a relationship even when deep personal feelings are not shared.

Unless this fundamental difference is understood and accepted, it can become a problem in your relationship. Mary may, at times, feel Peter is cold and aloof, and not as attentive as She would like. Peter needs a certain amount of distance, space for quiet contemplation, daydreaming, and just being alone. When he is in that state of mind, even Mary's loving attention could feel like an annoying disruption.

When couples are unable to accept these diverging viewpoints and approaches, it can bring much unhappiness. Interestingly, despite these contrasts, the relationship often remains unbreakable. When this

happens, although the differences are often obvious to others, they probably go unnoticed by the two of you. People may wonder what keeps you together when you seem so different on all fronts.

Of course, the 6 and the 7 also have the potential to create a happy, long-lasting relationship. The key is simply to recognize the fundamental difference in the way you express your love. Mary must realize that even when Peter seems distant, his love is not absent in any way. And Peter may have to accept the fact that Mary needs frequent reassurance (and will likely demand attention if you are remiss in demonstrating it).

Keep in mind that this is just one area of your chart; other numbers and influences could mitigate these differences. However, the 6 and 7 will always have their unique approaches to love (and romance).
