## About Your Relationship Profile

This report analyzes the personalities of both subjects to assess their compatibility. It also offers suggestions for ways to mitigate the stress or damage that can come from differing personalities and perspectives.

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## Life Path

*Your Life Path number is considered the single most significant information available in your Personality Chart. It is derived from the total of all numbers found in your date of birth. However, it is important to keep in mind that the aspects described in the next few chapters will either complement, supplement, or sometimes weaken the attributes revealed in numbers derived from your name.*

## **John, your Life Path is 45/9**

You are the philanthropist, humanitarian, socially conscious, and are deeply concerned about the state of the world. You have great compassion and idealism. You are a utopian, and will spend your life trying to realize some aspect of your utopian dream, sacrificing money, time, and energy for a better world. It is in giving that you will find much satisfaction. You have a broad outlook on life. You tend to see the big picture, rather than the minute details. You naturally attract people from all walks of life who can fit into your larger plans and take over the areas you find uninteresting (for more about your Life Path number, see you Personality Profile)

## **Pat, your Life Path is 13/4**

You are practical, down to earth with strong ideas about right and wrong. You are orderly and organized, systematic and controlled, you are decisive and methodical employing a step by step rational approach to problems solving. Once committed you do not give up easily. You are not one for "get rich quick" schemes. Rather you use hard work and long hours to build a business or career; you seek to establish a solid foundation (for more about your Life Path number, see you Personality Profile)

## **Your Life Path's Compatibility is 45/9 and 13/4**

John and Pat, this part of the chart reveals important differences you will need to address to create a satisfying, long-lasting relationship. Your challenges stem from the difficulty the 4 and 9 have seeing eye-to-eye. The problem is not so much that they are incompatible, they simply don't understand each other.

As you continue reading this section keep in mind this is only one aspect of the chart; you are complex individuals with many additional influences. It is possible that other numbers will mitigate the potential lack of connection often experienced in your combination, and this will not become an issue. However, even with that consideration, you likely have many challenges ahead.

Have you ever met someone you had an immediate dislike for, or perhaps just experienced an inability to relate to on almost any level? No two numbers generate that kind of inexplicable, uncomfortable vibration as clearly as the 4 and the 9. Fortunately, if you are currently in a successful relationship (and not in the early stages of seeing how you feel about someone) you most likely carry other numbers in your chart that are compatible to such an extent that they override this concern.

John and Pat, the success of your relationship lies in large part on your willingness to give each other a great deal of freedom. Think of this relationship as two strangers who

love each other. Some relationships require deep, intimate sharing of ideas, even secrets and inner experiences. This would most likely not only be uncomfortable for you, but it may not be possible. You carry very different attitudes and approaches to life. Oddly, in your relationship the motto should probably be: the less I know the better. The less you try to "understand" your partner, the more you will be able to allow love to meld your hearts. Openness, acceptance and respect are key.

Pat (the 4), you will need to accept John's need to devote time and attention to people and projects you do not relate to or are not passionate about. John (the 9) will need to compromise as well. As idealistic as John is, he can sometimes be self-righteous and annoyingly opinionated and likely irritated by Pat's practical nature. You will never change your partner. Even with the best intentions, asking them to see things from your perspective will be counterproductive and often create more distance, confusion, and alienation.

There is hope, however, and the potential for a successful, loving relationship if you can accept the fact that you will frequently take different paths. Understand there will most likely always be some distance between you. But if there is, remember that a little separation is the only thing that makes it possible for you to live in harmony. Eliminate the distance and the harmony will no longer exist.

## Expression

*Your Expression number, calculated from your full name at birth, reveals the orientation or goal of your life. Some numerologists refer to this as your Destiny number because it represents a lifelong target at which you are aiming. Thus, the Expression number, to some extent, reveals the person you aim to be.*

*Your Expression is the most influential of the three characteristics that make up who you are. It is also the number with the most influence on your choice of career, although other aspects are important as well.*

### **John, your Expression Number is 12/3**

You are optimistic, inspiring, outgoing, and expressive. People see you as cheerful, positive and charming; your personality has a certain bounce and verve that so powerfully affects others that you can inspire people without effort. All of this upward energy is a symptom of your tremendous creativity. Your verbal skills may well lead you into the fields of writing, comedy, theater, and music. Yours is the number of self-expression -- rich in imagination and spirit (for more about your Expression number, see you Personality Profile)

### **Pat, your Expression Number is 9**

You are the humanitarian. You are attracted to a cause or a movement whose purpose is to make a better world. You are idealistic, sometimes to the point of being naive about people or methods. You have great compassion and seek to create a more humane society. You are drawn to those who suffer physically or are at the hand of injustice. You are the righter of wrongs. Your deepest intention is to transform the world. You have a broad view of humanity and are not shackled with prejudice. You should have friends and associates from all walks of life, all colors and religious backgrounds (for more about your Expression number, see you Personality Profile)

## Your Expression's Compatibility is 12/3 and 9

John and Pat, this aspect of the chart reflects excellent compatibility. The 3 and the 9 have the potential to form a strong bond, one that lasts for a very long time - if not forever. They represent archetypes that are almost mythical in their romantic alliance. Many stories of patience and self-sacrifice could be told about this union. What makes this so surprising is the fact that your compatibility is possible even though both numbers are considered self-centered, even egocentric at times.

Your numbers indicate you both have powerful imaginations and intense inner lives. This makes you very creative, albeit in very different ways. John has a unique, somewhat offbeat originality, and is comfortable with life's unexpected turns and events. Pat likes to manipulate the environment until everything is harmonious. Also creative, she has the talent to combine colors and materials to create beauty in a disciplined manner. John appreciates the way Pat seems to control events and surroundings and Pat envies the easy manner that John accepts and takes advantage of whatever life serves up. John, your 3 in this part of the chart is often compared to the sun: you are warm, inspiring, and uplifting to all. Pat, your number 9 is the most idealistic and self-sacrificing number. Like the 3, it offers love freely and generously □ although the 9 tends to focus on humanitarian concerns. Both are loving, generous, and worldly numbers(who never forget they are at the center of whatever they offer).

Vying for the same limelight could create conflict □ a little like politicians in an election run-off. Even if, privately, they respect and like one another, they compete for attention (even slinging mud if they feel it is justified). Fortunately, this is pretty much the only area where the 3 and 9 combination might encounter problems. Avoid competition and invest in the caring, romantic, life-long unity that (otherwise) comes naturally to both of you.

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## Heart's Desire

*The Expression number described above points to a more productive side of your life. Your Heart's Desire reflects a deeper, inner you; it suggests an underlying urge, your true motivation, and the general intention behind many of your actions. It reveals the environment and lifestyle you prefer, as well as your likes, dislikes, and the type of people you are drawn to. Consequently, it dramatically influences the choices you make in life.*

*It makes sense that the vowels of your name are the foundation for your Heart's Desire. Vowels are the peaks and valleys of a language. Notice how vowels leave your mouth in a free-flowing breath. Try it: Aaaa.... Eeee.... Oooo.. Consonants though, are cut off either at the beginning or in the end. You might say that it is in the flow of your breath that you express your deeper self.*

### **John, your Heart's Desire is 13/4**

You like to live a stable, well organized life. You dislike sudden changes. You prefer orderliness in all things. You have a systematic mind that is reflected in everything you do. ### **Your Heart's Desire's Compatibility is 13/4 and 22/4**

John and Pat, you both have a 4 in this part of the chart, indicating a relationship that is either very compatible or extremely stressful. Your lifestyle preferences are likely very similar and you both prefer a certain amount of predictability and routine in your lives.

This does not mean you don't enjoy a surprise on occasion, but you generally want your daily routine to be firmly established and uninterrupted.

The success of your relationship relies largely on how compatible your daily routines are. Details are important because you both tend to become irritated when your carefully established schedules are disturbed. It is important that you respect each other's needs and habits. Even if other numbers in your respective charts point to a certain amount of flexibility and adaptability, you probably have a tendency to create environments that are finely tuned and designed to accommodate your daily physical, mental and spiritual needs.

Unless your habits are compatible, it will be difficult for you to sustain this relationship without making a few adjustments (other than the necessary give-and-take of any relationship). Neither of you should severely limit your needs or desires to accommodate the other as it will only work in the short term; try to arrange a somewhat separate routine instead. It is better to give each other room than to force things that are uncomfortable, creating minor annoyances that can turn into growing sources of resentment.

John and Pat, you are both reliable, dependable people who honor your promises. Being able to count on each other is a powerful ally in your relationship. However, if taken too far, your grounded, practical nature can also create a rigid lifestyle that could lead to frustration and gradual alienation from friends and family members. Lacking tolerance and acceptance of other people's lifestyles can put a stranglehold on your social life and, indirectly, a strain on your relationship. Your keywords for a successful, rewarding relationship are tolerance and flexibility.

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## Personality

*The consonants of your full name at birth are the foundation of your Personality number, which is a little like a narrow entrance hall to the great room that is your true nature. It's the outer layer of your personality, the part you feel more or less comfortable sharing. With time and trust, you invite others into the deeper aspects of your nature.*

*Your Personality number serves as a censoring device in terms of what you send out, as well as whom and what you allow to approach. For this reason, your Personality is usually much more narrow and protective in its definition than the real you. It also gives an indication of how others perceive you.*

**John, your Personality is 17/8**

You appear strong and powerful. You have an impressive personality and can influence and even intimidate through sheer force. You have natural authority. Your competence and enthusiasm attract people with resources. You radiate confidence. People defer to you because they sense your sureness and effectiveness (for more about your Personality number, see your Personality Profile)

## **Pat, your Personality is 14/5**

You are a stimulating person. You brighten social gatherings with your fresh and original ideas. Your conversation tends to be sprinkled with novelty and wit. You have a quick tongue and charisma. You are probably an excellent salesman. There is a lot of nervous energy within you looking for an outlet. You love your freedom and you see this life as an ongoing adventure (for more about your Personality number, see your Personality Profile)

## **Your Personality's Compatibility is 17/8 and 14/5**

John and Pat, this particular aspect of your chart suggests compatibility can only exist if your roles in the relationship are very different and somewhat separate. You both have unique qualities, but they rarely overlap. Perhaps the best way to describe the differences between your numbers is to look at them from a business rather than a romantic perspective.

As business partners, you could do very well - as long as you play different roles. The 5 (Pat) is excellent at promotion and sales. She is dynamic, articulate, thinks fast, and finds solutions easily. Because Pat can see through facades better than most people, it is easy for her to influence others and resolve personality issues.

John, is a visionary, has a strong commanding presence, and has the persistence to overcome obstacles. The eye of the 8 is always intently focused on a future goal - a goal that will be met no matter what. John is the executive, Pat the marketing expert. These are very different qualities that can work well together as long as they recognize neither should try to tell the other how to do their job.

In a romantic relationship between the 5 and the 8, a similar picture emerges. As long as you do not tell your partner how to behave or what to consider a priority, things should be fine.

Other issues that appear in this combination have to do with John's assertive personality and Pat's social nature. Pat does not do well being told what to do, and quickly rejects authority. John, may become jealous or envious of Pat's social life and many friends.

Your key to a successful relationship lies in giving one another space and freedom. Your relationship can be pleasant and long lasting, but you will probably need to be realistic about your expectations, and maintain some distance in your lifestyles and day-to-day routines.

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## **Maturity Number**

*Your Maturity number indicates an underlying wish or desire that gradually surfaces at around age 30 to 35. A direction begins to emerge as you gain a better understanding of yourself. With this self-knowledge comes a greater awareness of who you are, and the direction you want to set for your life. Your Maturity numbers are described in detail in your Personality Profiles.*

### **Pat, your Maturity Number is 4**

Systematic and organized, there are few goals out of your reach. You have determination, perseverance and self-discipline. You are perceived as solid as a rock and just as reliable. Your family and friends have faith in you and your ability to care for them. You are practical and realistic. You are also concerned about the welfare of your community. You love nature and the beauty and efficiency that characterize natural law. You have sound judgment and understanding when it comes to estimating the value of a plan or the feasibility of an enterprise. You have good concentration.

You identify with work and are can be very unhappy if you are in a job you do not love. You have a sharp eye for detail. You enjoy the security and steadiness of schedules. You do not like the unexpected.

Your family and home are very important to you. Your love runs deep and is extremely loyal and protective.

## **Your Maturity's Compatibility is 3 and 4**

This is a very promising as well as a very difficult combination. John has an optimistic, creative, playful, perhaps even childlike nature. He has faith in life, confident that everything will work out in the end. John has a natural, intuitive ability to go with the flow and avoid pitfalls almost effortlessly. Pat, on the other hand, is much more grounded and practical, with a hands-on approach to life. She understands that discipline, focus, responsibility, and duty are required for a life of comfort and contentment. From one perspective, these traits create a nicely balanced relationship. But when challenges arise, especially around practical issues, the 3 and 4 combination is one of the least prepared to deal with it.

John, when problems arise (such as financial concerns, loss of employment, or a costly illness) you may resent Pat's relentlessly systematic way of handling things; Pat is not the type of person to sit back and watch things fall apart. And Pat will likely question the amount of effort and sacrifice John is willing to make during a difficult period. Blame can feed resentment and anger which can turn you against each other and keep you from acting together to overcome obstacles.

It is important for you both to recognize and accept the differences in your personalities and perspectives. You will often take a different approach than your partner. This may not be easy because you are both likely to question how your partner could respond so differently to what you believe is the correct and required approach. John may believe all the effort Pat is making is unnecessary or misdirected, perhaps even detrimental to a positive outcome. Pat may blame you for not making more of an effort (which may be true).

John, try to understand that Pat needs to take practical steps to feel she has some control over the situation. Pat, although it may look like John is backing away from or downplaying a problem, try to understand his more indirect approach to dealing with the issue (which could be an effect of trying to make it go away or make it more bearable). Appreciate John's optimism as he points to the light at the end of the tunnel. Although this may not seem particularly practical, it can motivate both of you when you are just about to give up.

Although your differing perspectives could make things difficult at times, yours is a very

promising combination. The key to making it the best relationship it can be lies in combining your individual qualities and not judging one another.
